The idea of punctuality has been hard wired into our psyche since our childhood. Weren't we taught from school days to be on time, and that 'Punctuality' is a virtue? Then when did we fall out? why is considered cool to say "Indian Standard Time", and be done with the guilt of not keeping Time? Has our culture written off the importance of being punctual as insignificant and inconsequential? In Japan, where being on time is of utmost importance, punctuality is referred to as 'Jikangenshu' - which loosely translates as "strictly defending time". Earlier this year there was an incident in Japan, where Japan's Olympics minister had made a public apology for being THREE minutes late for a parliamentary meeting, after being criticized by MPs. They said he had shown disrespect for his office and subsequently boycotted a meeting of the Games' budgetary committee for five hours.

Punctuality should be made not only a point of courtesy but a point of conscience. Being late is a selfish act, for it puts your needs above another's. You want an extra minute to do what you'd like, but in gaining that minute for yourself, you take a minute from another, which is why...... being late is a form of stealing. That's a tough truth, but it's a truth nonetheless. When you make others wait for you, you rob minutes from them that they'll never get back. Time they could have turned into money, or simply used for the things important to them. Emergencies however are an exemption. Once or twice in our life may be unavoidable but being late consistently makes us unreliable.

Do we even stop to think about what will happen if a doctor gets late to reach the operation theatre or a student




