25/11/2020 - Rtn. Suraj Sivadasan spoke on digital marketing. He explained how social media can be used as a tool in brand building and connecting with the target group.



3/11/2020 - Eyeserve - Eye camp was conducted for the employees of Powersonic Ltd. Sulur. Total number of people screened was 63 and 16 employees were advised to go for further treatment.

20/11/2020 - Eyeserve An eyecamp was conducted at Eachanari . The total number of people screened was 226. Follow up treatment was suggested for 57 people.

21/11/2020 - Eyeserve - An eyecamp was conducted at Eachanari for the second day. 300 employees were screened and 87 cases were reported for further treatment.

24/11/2020 - Eyeserve - An eyecamp was conducted at Equitas bank and the total number of people screened was 67 and 23 people were identified for follow up treatment.

According to him, in the future, agriculture will use sophisticated technologies like robots, temperature and moisture control sensors, along with GPS technology.
